Pedigree Commercially grown in the US since the 1980's.

Maturity Early

Yield 1000 - 1500 kg./ha. or 900 - 1340 lb./ac.

Growth Habit Fairly neat

Disease/Pest Susceptibility Can display reaction to Prunus necrotic ring-spot virus infection. Moderately resistant to downy mildew. Sensitive to insects, in particular mites.

Pickability/Drying/Baling Fair to good

Cone-Structure Medium-compact, fairly small light cone.

Lupulin Moderate amount, pale yellow.

Aroma Slightly spicy

Alpha Acid 4.0 - 5.0% w/w

Beta Acid 3.0 - 4.0% w/w

Cohumulone 20 -25% of alpha acids

Storageability 55 - 60% of alpha acids remaining after 6 months storage at 20°C

Total Oil 0.4 - 0.8 mls/100 grams

Myrcene 0.4 - 0.8 mls/100 grams

Humulene 18 - 23% of whole oil

Carophyllene 6 - 7% of whole oil

Farnesene 5 - 8% of whole oil
